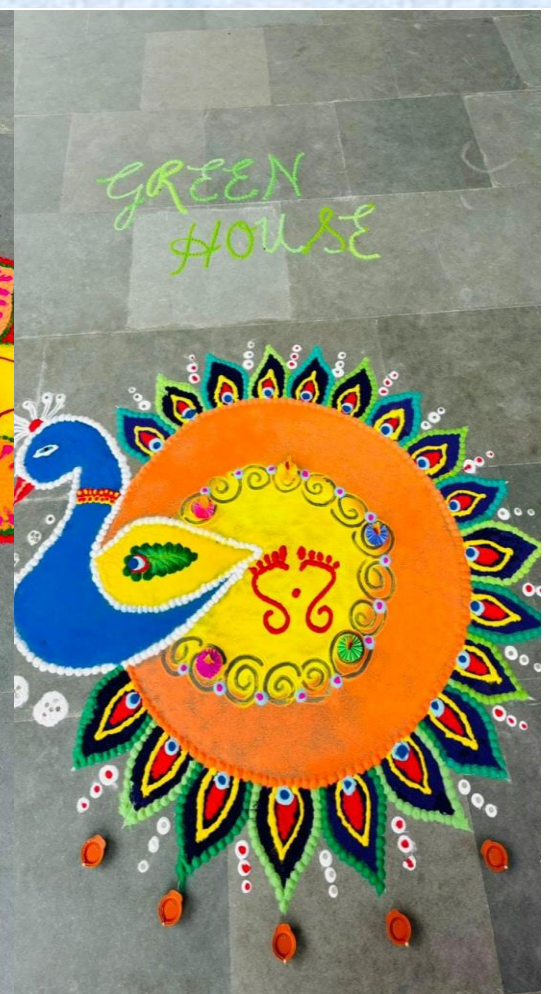


Rangoli Making Competition

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CANDLE DECORATION ACTIVITY

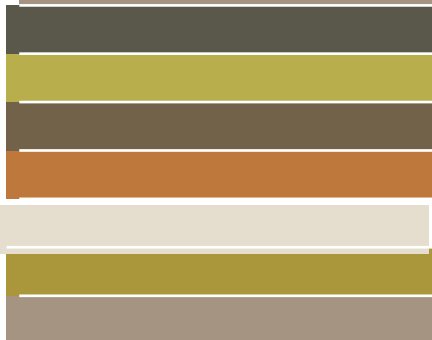


Candle Decoration Activity was held on 9th November, 2023 at St. Paul Preparatory School, where all the students took part with great enthusiasm and showcased their talents.
