CALLIGRAPHY COMPETITION



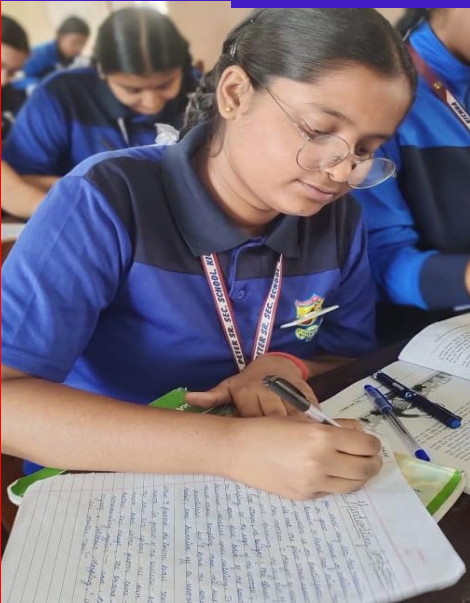
