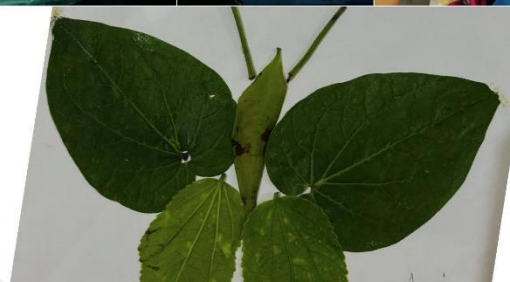

- Riddles

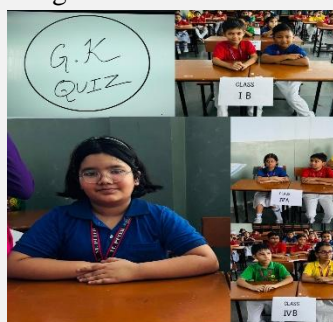
